## BIO

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Peter von Philipsborn is a medical doctor and a public health researcher at Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München (LMU Munich), working at the crossroads of research, policy and practice. With a background in medicine, political science, economics and law, he specialises on public health nutrition, with a particular focus on policy-level interventions for supporting healthy and sustainable diets.

His areas of expertise and interest include prevention of obesity and diabetes, food environment and food policy research, methods for evidence-based public health (including systematic reviews, guideline development, and integrated knowledge translation), policy analysis as well as qualitative and mixed methods in public health.

Within Food-SAMSA, he acts as principal investigator for LMU Munich and as LMU's representative in the Management Board, taking responsibility for the project's overall direction. Besides, he is co-lead for several work packages, in particular work packages 2 and 3, which focus on the assessment of public and private sector policies influencing the double burden of malnutrition on a population level.
